



Spring 2026 Communications Internship

The Agricultural Stewardship Association (ASA) is a community-supported, nonprofit conservation organization located in Greenwich, NY. Our mission is to protect the community's working farms and forests, connect people to the land, and promote a vibrant future for agriculture and forestry in the region. Since 1990, ASA has conserved 183 properties totaling more than 33,693 acres of land, including two community forests.

ASA seeks a motivated Communications Intern to support our outreach and storytelling efforts. This paid, part-time position (approx. 15 hours/week) is hybrid remote, with a mix of remote work and occasional in-person collaboration. It is ideal for a student in their final year of undergraduate study or a graduate student pursuing a master's degree.

This internship will report to ASA's Community Engagement Manager, and offers hands-on experience in nonprofit communications while contributing to ASA's mission of protecting working lands.

Responsibilities include:

- Drafting and editing articles, press releases, and other written content
- Assisting with social media planning, writing, and posting
- Supporting communications projects related to farmland and forest conservation, agriculture, and community engagement
- Helping maintain content calendars and communications materials as needed

Qualifications:

- Final-year undergraduate student or master's-level student in communications, journalism, marketing, or a related field
- Strong writing and editing skills
- Familiarity with social media platforms
- Interest in agriculture, conservation, or nonprofit communications preferred
- Organized, detail-oriented, and able to work independently and as part of a team.
- Excellent interpersonal, oral, and written communication skills.
- Proficiency with the Microsoft Office suite.
- Ability to sit and work on a computer up to 4-5 hours a day
- Reliable transportation. Willingness to travel with mileage reimbursement included.

Employment Terms:

- \$19/hr and the ability to work up to 15 hours per week, which may include an occasional evening or weekend as arranged in advance.
- Ability to work between **mid-February and mid-June**, or as arranged. (flexible start/end dates)
- This is a part-time, temporary internship position and is not eligible for benefits.
